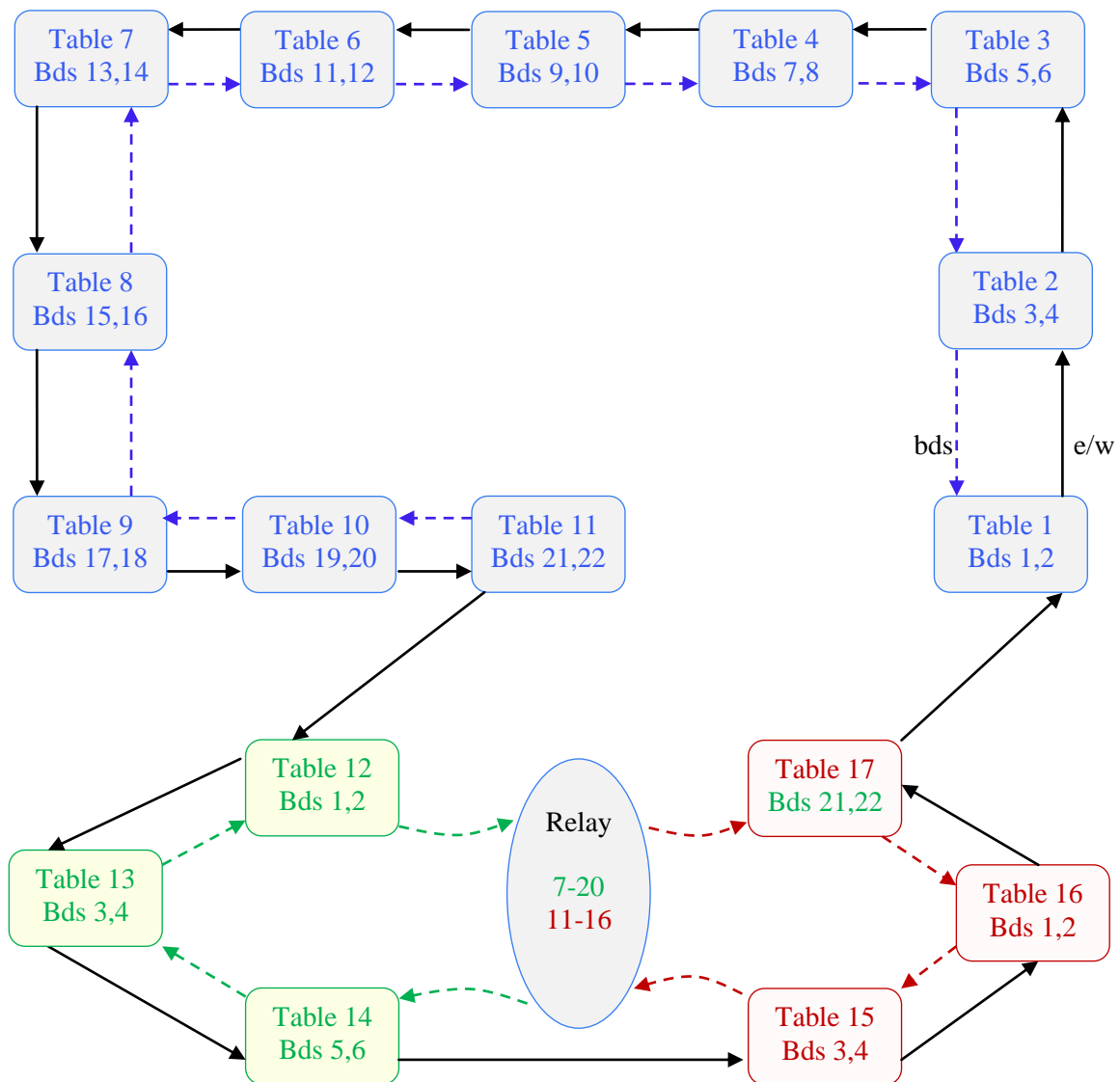


Table and Board Diagram – 17 Table Web Mitchell
11 rounds, 22 boards



A web movement for an odd number of tables requires two and a half sets of boards. The pair movement is completely standard - EW pairs move up one table each round.

Boards are divided into three sections. Tables 1 – 11 and Tables 12 – 14 need two complete sets of 22 boards, Tables 15 – 17 need third copy of boards 1,2,3,4,and 11-16.

Boards move down one table each round, and sit out on a relay table after they've been played at the lowest numbered table in the section.

The initial board layout is that Tables 1-11 start with boardsets 1-11. Tables 12-14 start with boardsets 1-3. Table 17 starts with boardset 11, Table 16 with boardset 1 and so on: tables 12-17 are effectively their own little even web movement.

Note that NS pairs in the highest numbered section will play boardsets in reverse order - eg they play boards 5-6 after 7-8.
